#### UNITED NATIONS CONGRESS

Several papers will be presented by members of the Australian delegation to the Eight United Nations Congress on the Prevention of Crime and Treatment of Offenders, to be held in Havana, Cuba from 27th August to 7th September.

#### **CRIMINAL JUSTICE LIBRARIANS'** CONFERENCE

The Seventh Conference for Librarians in the CJS was held in Canberra from 29 to 31 May at Burgmann College, Australian National University. The Conference organised and hosted by the Australian Institute of Criminology, attracted participants from a wide range of organisations including correctional and police agencies, prosecuting bodies, government law departments and academic law departments.

The theme of the Conference was Information for the 1990s and Beyond. The program included sessions on the use of electronic mail services for criminal justice professionals, and the applications of CD-ROM technology in the legal and criminal justice environment. Other papers of particular interest to librarians in the criminal justice area dealt with prison library services, sources of statistical information, and case studies of libraries. Demonstrations and trade displays were a feature of the Conference. Conference participants were given hands-on opportunities to access electronic mail services, online bibliographic databases and CD-ROM products.

During the Conference Australian Prison Libraries : Minimum Standard Guidelines was launched by Chief Justice Jeffrey Miles of the ACT Supreme Court. Compiled by Philip Roberts, the book was published by the Australian Library and Information Association as an ALIA endorsed standard.

Selected proceedings of Conference will be published at a later date.

#### UNITED NATIONS CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION NETWORK

A new service on UNCJIN is the AIDS Data Information Base (Copyright, Washington DC).

The service is accessed at System Command level by entering "Q" then "AIDS". The AIDS information service offers an historical database of the AIDS Daily Summary which can be accessed by keyword and date. A search of the database under the keywords "prison or prisoners or prisons" revealed 173 occurrences, and a search under "corrections or correctional" produced 47 occurrences. Many of the summaries dealt with the topic of segregation of prisoners with AIDS - one currently of concern to the correctional administrators.

# HIV/AIDS AND PRISONS 19-21 November 1990, Melbourne

The issue of HIV/AIDS in the Australian prison system raises many complex issues. This conference will look at what is known and needs to be known about HIV/AIDS in the prison population, policies and programs designed to deal with HIV/AIDS in prisons, and legal issues. The Conference will also address HIV/AIDS and juvenile institutions, and community based corrections.

#### DNA PROFILING IN COURT

Canberra Legal Symposium Series - 27-28 October 1990, 10-11 November 1990, Canberra

Forensic evidence based on DNA profiling ("fingerprinting") has been a contributory factor in over 100 criminal convictions in the United States and resolved more than 3,000 kinship and paternity cases in the United Kingdom. Australian forensic laboratories and courts of law are turning increasingly to DNA profiling to furnish definite proof of identity and pedigree. This accredited instruction program is sponsored jointly by the Australian National University (Faculty of Science and Faculty of Law) and the Australian Institute of Criminology. It is designed especially to cover the practical needs of judges and lawyers in evaluating this new evidence. The course will be presented by internationally respected authorities in the principles and practice of the technologies of DNA profiling and will include substantial "hands-on" instruction.

# INTERNATIONAL TRENDS IN CRIME: EAST MEETS WEST

10-13 December 1990, Nusa Dua, Bali, Indonesia

First Annual Conference of the Indonesian Society of Criminology in conjunction with the Australian Institute of Criminology and The Netherlands Council for Co-operation with Indonesia in Legal Matters.
